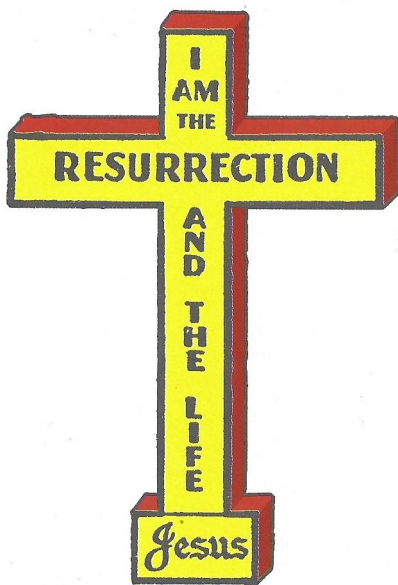


FOUR THINGS GOD WANTS YOU TO KNOW



“But these things are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name” (John 20:31).

FIRST — You Need to Be Saved.

“Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God” (John 3:3).

“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God” (Romans 3:23).

"There is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not" (Ecclesiastes 7:20).

"We are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags" (Isaiah 64:6).

"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" (Jer. 17:9).

"All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way" (Isaiah 53:6).

SECOND — You Cannot Save Yourself.

"Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us" (Titus 3:5).

"By the works of the law shall no flesh be justified" (Galatians 2:16).

"For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all" (James 2:10).

"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death" (Prov. 14:12).

"Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me" (John 14:6).

THIRD — Jesus Has Already Provided for Your Salvation.

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (John 3:16).

"For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God" (I Peter 3:18).

"Who [Jesus] his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes

ye were healed" (I Peter 2:24).

FOURTH — Jesus Will Enable You to Overcome Temptation.

"Him [Jesus] who knew no sin he [God] made to be sin on our behalf; that we might become the righteousness of God in him" (II Cor. 5:21 R.V.).

"The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished" (II Peter 2:9).

"There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape" (I Corinthians 10:13).

"If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed" (John 8:36).

"If any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new" (II Corinthians 5:17).

YOUR PART

Repent

"Except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish" (Luke 13:3). i.e. change your mind to God.

Believe

"Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house" (Acts 16:31).

"For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus" (I Timothy 2:5).

Confess Your Sins to Jesus

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (I John 1:9).

Confess Jesus Before Men

"Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven" (Matt. 10:32).

"If thou shalt confess with thy mouth Jesus as Lord, and shalt believe in thy heart that God raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved" (Romans 10:9 R.V.).

DO IT NOW

"Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near" (Isaiah 55:6).

"Behold, now is the day of salvation" (II Cor. 6:2).

"How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation?" (Hebrews 2:3).

"Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you" (Matthew 6:33).

"Boast not thyself of tomorrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth" (Proverbs 27:1).

"For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?" (Mark 8:36).

REMEMBER

"Every one of us shall give account of himself to God" (Romans 14:12).

"It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment" (Hebrews 9:27); but he that "believeth on him [God] . . . shall not come into condemnation" (John 5:24).
